

WHAT IS A CATECHIST?

A catechist for SJN's Kindergarten-5th grade program is someone who teaches children the Catholic faith in a classroom setting.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIRMENTS?

- You DO NOT have to have any teaching experience to be a catechist.
- You DO NOT need to have a background in theology.
- You DO have to be a member of St. John Neumann parish.
- You DO have to be compliant with the Diocese of Arlington Protecting God's Children program.
- You DO have to be a practicing Catholic and have a desire to share God's love with the children of SJN!

WHAT ARE THE EXPECTATIONS?

- You should believe the Catholic teachings and share those beliefs with your class.
- You should be able to attend every class session on time or notify us if you need a substitute catechist.
- You should be able to create and teach a lesson each week geared toward your grade level. (Materials and guidance will be provided!)
- You should have a basic understanding of classroom management.
- You should bring the love and joy of Jesus Christ into your classroom!

I WANT TO SIGN UP, WHAT COMES NEXT?

- Fill out the form to the right, tear it off, and drop it in the box outside the Faith Formation Office
- Our Coordinator of Children's Faith Formation, Thomas Patchan, will contact you within one week and plan a time to meet.
- You will be assigned a class based on your preference of day/time/grade.
 Each class has no more than 16 students. You will also be paired with another catechist or class aide. You can request your co-catechist or one will be assigned with you.
- You will be given a catechist guide book and benchmarks to help plan your lessons. You will also have access to our Catechist Library and Catechist Supply Closet.
- All catechists will be asked to attend catechist training nights throughout the year.

I WANT TO BE A CATECHIST, BUT I CANNOT COMMIT TO EVERY WEEK...

Be a <u>substitute catechist</u>! We are in need of volunteers who will be on our official 'sub list' in case one of our regular catechist cannot make class. You will not be expected to write a lesson plan, but be available to fill in if needed.

The requirements to be a sub are the same as a catechist. We ask that you sign up for a specific day/time when you would most often be available.
